Attacks on Communities

WAY FORWARD

- Mass-based action [through community structures]
- Dedicated telephone number at every police station and 10111 for reporting, PC office for station commissioners to report
- Information networks to be established
- Shelter – SAPS will liaise through CPF's with NGO's and CBO's within police station precincts
- Safety nets in communities

WAY FORWARD

- **Safety Forum**
- **Focus** – Safety in communities
- **Purpose** – sharing information, verification, decide on action, communicate and mobilize relevant structures
- [4] law enforcement: DPP, SAPS, NIA, CI
- [1] Provincial Government: 0860 142 142
- [3] civil society, Disaster man [1], Religious Sector [1]
- Flow of information – from 148 police stations [through community structures] to Provincial Office
- Report-back from SAFETY FORUM – frequency depend on situation, broader forum meet bi-weekly

• Cluster Stations – inform other stations

- PROV OFFICE reporting **021 467 8086**
- By Thursday – meeting with community structures (CPF) and feedback at PCCF
- Activate station structures
- Dedicated number at each police station- nr's by Wednesday to ISM
- 4 trained persons to address reported incidents
- Communication not at station – SAFETY FORUM central point of media liaison
- Communication officials – replicate message of SC, account to SC
- Cluster Stations – inform other stations
